Motion made and carried to approve minutes from 5/7/22 Intergroup meeting

Agenda Item #1: Committee Reports:

A. Treasury Report: Deana G reported \$1,150.03 in the treasury currently. \$180 is earmarked for the literature / t shirt fund. The following bills have been paid; Zoom 1 (paid til 1/7/23) & Zoom 2 (paid til 2/11/23), P.O. box (paid til 9/30/22), domain (paid til 6/28/23), and website (paid til 6/15/24).

Group decided no donations will be made to Region or WSO at this time.

Motion made and unanimously carried to accept the Treasury report.

B. Literature report: T shirts and literature were sold at last Saturday's (5/28) recovery breakfast. The amount made is unknown. Joe G stated inventory is plentiful.

Motion made and unanimously carried to accept the Literature report.

C. Technology / Newsletter report:

Deana G reported there were 542 website views, and 286 unique views in May. She stated there are currently 230 in the RI Area mailing list. Deana stated the Zoom meetings are not well funded.

Motion made and unanimously carried to accept the Technology and Newsletter report.

D. Region report: Chris C stated the Region is looking for new memberships and service (multiple positions open). Discussion at the regional meeting continued on how to assist Intergroups and individual groups.

Motion made and unanimously carried to accept the region report.

E. Outreach report: The May breakfast went well. It was noted that promoting it through the email list and newsletter drew people there.

Speaker event- The committee is looking for a speaker and a location. for a talk in November. Discussion included reaching out to Melody Beattie or Brown University faculty to speak. The committee will be meeting sometime in June to plan further.

Joe G. stated there may be a new meeting starting up in Fall River soon. Should Intergroup be involved with start up assistance for that and other new groups?

Joe presented a proposal for ACA Region to consider underwriting new group start ups for RI Area ACA. Joe's proposal included; providing \$300 to new groups for rent, literature, etc. Can ACA Region underwrite 80% (\$240) of that amount?

Motion made and unanimously carried to present to ACA Region a letter requesting funding for new groups in RI Area.

F. WSO- No report. Intergroup currently does not have a rep.
